

A Risk assessment has been undertaken of our premises inside the dance area. You will also need to be advised from the school of any separate risk assessment in place from any academic school that Stephanie works from regarding after school clubs.

It has been confirmed that our Public liability Insurance is still in force during the Pandemic.

Agreeing to the terms and conditions and Code of Ethics and Behaviours of Stephaneez School of Dance and also agree to appropriate privacy notices and data sharing as outlined under the GDPR.

Procedures have been put in place to comply with NATD and Government Track & Trace principles which includes keeping a register of attendees at all dance classes.

If any pupil believes that they have an underlying health condition and has any concerns they should contact me in strict confidence so that any additional measures can be identified and implemented. NATD recommends that individual pupils should then make a personal decision whether to re-start class. All pupils should undergo a self-assessment check prior to attending dance class on the morning of.

NATD/SSOD encourages all pupils to follow Government advice for safe travel including minimising the use of Public Transport and only travel with people in your household or bubble.

Pupils should follow all Stephaneez School of Dance protocols.

Hygiene – in line with government advice we recommend that all pupils, officials wash their hands before and after activity and regularly use hand sanitiser which is available at the entrance to the venues.

Pupils should bring their own water-bottles which will need to be clearly named. The kitchens WILL NOT be in use at all. Dancers should always avoid touching other dancers drinking bottles.

At no point should any pupil touch any of Miss Stephanie Dance equipment.

MASKS/SHIELDS.

As we are all aware at the moment, Gov. UK on the advise of wearing masks and shields within a teaching environment varies, whether in the teaching bubble or an external.

Miss Stephanie has personally been strongly advised by the association to wear a mask /shield or both whilst teaching.

Clothing : Please wear appropriate clothing and bring plenty of layers as the venues will be well ventilated /after school clubs children will remain in their uniform.

The need to reduce as much contact between parents/carers when dropping off and picking up. I.e. limit drop off and pick up to one adult per family.

Parents and carers should not wait on the premises but outside the school gates or as instructed by the individual academic schools, parents/carers must maintain physical distancing at all times and respect that the venues can be used by other organisations using the same premises.
